From the evening of Friday 13th to after lunch on Sunday 15th June, "*Kingdom Come*" will offer time to relax, worship, meet friends from across our congregations, and have some great quality teaching.

A key part of our vision as a parish is that we become a community of people who help one another live out our whole life—at home, work, church and in the neighbourhood—as followers of Jesus in his mission in the world. This doesn't affect a chosen few on a Sunday morning, but rather is for everyone, everywhere, everyday and in everything. This is a crucial part of "going deeper" and "reaching further".

Our Venue

Cefn Lea is located in a lovely setting in the Welsh borders, just a few miles from Newtown and about an hour's drive from Shrewsbury.

A number of churches and other organisations use Cefn Lea for their conferences, and it served as a great venue for our 2010 and 2012 Parish Weekends Away. It offers full catering and a broad range of accommodation to suit different needs, including de luxe, en suite chalets and plenty of space for those who would prefer to camp or would value a single room.

Outdoors there are play areas for children, tennis courts, fishing (bring your own tackle), golf and signposted forest trail and walks; Indoors has a play area, cinema, sports halls (football, badminton, basketball etc.) and a range of conference and meeting rooms.

Our Speaker

We're delighted that **Alasdair Macleod** is going to be our speaker.

He worked as a buyer for Nissan Europe in his twenties and after studying at the London School of Theology went on to lead a church in Watford. His wife Alison works as an A&E doctor and they have two young children. Music and sports are a big feature of family life.





The Programme

Further and fuller details will be available nearer the event, but expect the following:

- Friday night, arrive, share a meal and join us for worship, introductions and our first teaching session. Late night prayer or a chance to relax together will follow.
- **Saturday morning**. Early morning prayer for the larks, followed by breakfast and a morning of worship and teaching.
- **Saturday afternoon.** Time to walk, play sport, sit around and talk, sleep; the choice is yours. There will also be some optional 'seminar' style groups at tea-time for those wanting to go a bit deeper in issues of discipleship in today's world.
- Saturday evening. Let your hair down with a family fun evening. There will also be opportunities in a more relaxed setting to go deeper in prayer and receiving from God. Then from 11pm for those who wish there will be opportunity for some late-night football with the England vs Italy World Cup Match.
- **Sunday morning.** Early morning prayer, breakfast, teaching sessions and a closing Communion. Followed by **Sunday** afternoon lunch and departure.

Youth and Children

At the 2012 Weekend Away there were 30 plus children and young people who had a great time of activities, play, learning and fun. There will be a separate age-related programme for children and young people during the main sessions, as well as opportunities for families and all-ages to enjoy time together. A crèche will also be provided.

There are limited free spaces available for those helping to lead work with children and young people. If you would be interested in joining a team, please indicate this on the booking form.

Being family – the cost of Cefn Lea

We recognise that finances are currently tough for some individuals and families. Having surveyed other churches our charges are at least 15% below what many charge for similar events; indeed we believe the weekend represents excellent value for a full board short break.
