6 ways to give to Trinity Churches



Regular standing order. Many people give this way. You can ask your bank to make regular (e.g. monthly) payments from your account directly into the churches' bank account. You can use the form on the back of this leaflet to set up a new standing order, or to update your existing giving.



Online Giving. You can now give to the church securely by giving through our website at www.trinitychurches.org/give. You can also give a donation of up to £20 with our contactless giving terminal at Holy Trinity Church.



Weekly envelope scheme. Some people give regularly by cash or cheque using numbered envelopes, placed in the collection plate at Sunday services.



Payroll giving. Some people give through charity payroll schemes.



One-off gifts. Sometimes people want to make a special gift – perhaps as a way of saying thank you to God, or to celebrate a special event.



Legacies. Some people choose to leave a legacy to Trinity Churches in their will.
