Job location Principally at Holy Trinity Church, Meole Brace, Shrewsbury

Hours TWO HOURS per week, plus additional hours when agreed. There is

a reasonable expectation to serve at most weddings, funerals and baptisms taking place at Holy Trinity Meole Brace. (In last 12 months

13 weddings, 18 funerals, 15 baptisms) Verger fees are paid

separately for each of these events.

Pay £10.53 per hour for contracted two hours. There are additional

agreed fees of £64 for each wedding (to include time spent at wedding rehearsal and wedding day), £43 for funeral, and c1½ hours

pay depending on length of baptism. (2023 fees, reviewed annually)

PURPOSE: To be on the frontline in welcoming people of all ages of life and

stages of faith to Meole Brace Church. You'll ensure that the Church building is prepared and ready as a place of welcome, hospitality and mission for our regular Sunday services as well

as weddings, funerals, baptisms and other events

KEY TASKS:

1. **Cherishing the building.** To ensure the church is clean, warm and welcoming for all who attend services and events at Meole Brace Church. This will include liaising with the regular church cleaner where appropriate.

- 2. Weddings, Funerals and Baptisms. To support the clergy team and others at weddings, funerals and where needed baptisms. To offer a warm welcome to all attending, taking care of practical arrangements such as seating, simple PA requirements, tidying the church and leaving the church ready for the next event. To liaise with other colleagues including funeral directors, musicians, photographers and bell ringers. You will also be expected to be present at wedding practices.
- 3. **Regular Sundays.** To ensure that the church is prepared prior to regular services during the week, particularly Sundays 9am and 11am, and monthly midweek services.

- 4. **A ministry of welcome.** To offer a welcome and prepare the building for other events during the week as they occur and as agreed.
- 5. **Communion Arrangements.** To clean the silver, wash communion linen and check supplies of Communion wafers and wine, candle oil and other such items. To change altar frontals according to the liturgical year.

To carry out such additional roles as are, from time to time, required.

RESPONSIBILITIES and REVIEW:

- 1. Meet with the Vicar, or nominated colleague, on a regular basis.
- 2. Liaise with the Events Manager and Office team about upcoming bookings, as well as responsibility to monitor secure online church diary.
- 3. A formal appraisal will be carried out annually.

TERMS OF APPOINTMENT

- 1. This is a permanent post subject to a six-month probation period.
- 2. A formal contract will be issued by the PCC of Meole Brace on commencement of employment.
- 3. Holiday entitlement is 5.6 weeks' paid holiday in each holiday year which is paid in accordance with the statutory provisions for roles where there are no normal hours of work.

PERSON SPECIFICATION

Essential

- 1. Ability to work as part of a team, and to develop positive working relationships with colleagues
- 2. Readiness to act professionally and pastorally with families we come into contact with, recognising the public nature of this role within the church's wider work
- **3.** Clear track record of working to a high standard, and noticing those "unseen things" which can both help or hinder our welcome as a church
- **4.** Love and care for both the amazing array of people who attend services and events as well as a beautiful historic Church building
- **5.** Ability to cope with stressful situations and competing demands, thinking ahead and "trouble-shooting" during services and events
- **6.** Basic skills in operating a computer to play sound files, CD player, and sound desk to alter sound levels for vocal microphones
- 7. Good communication skills and a 'listening ear'
- 8. Sympathetic to the Christian vision and ethos of Trinity Churches

This role involves moving elements of furniture and other objects around the church so appropriate physical fitness is required.

Desirable

- 1. Experience in pastoral care and coming alongside others
- 2. Experience of operating a PA system and computer, or strong ability to learn
- **3.** Experience of Christian worship and church services, especially the 'shape' of how weddings, funerals and baptisms are conducted.

SAFEGUARDING
